ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Successful candidates shall meet the following criteria:-

- Be the child of a 1st National Bank Employee.
- Be the child of a shareholder or customer of 1st National Bank.
Note: The Customer or Shareholder must be in good standing with the Bank.
- Student must attain a minimum score of 70% at Common Entrance Examinations
- Examination within the year in which the scholarship is to be awarded.
- Demonstrate the positive qualities of discipline and exemplary behaviour based on recommendations from the Principals of their former primary schools.
- Heavy emphasis will be placed on the socioeconomic status of the applicant

ENTITLEMENTS

The Scholarship shall be awarded for a five-year period and will normally entitle the recipient up to a maximum of \$1,500.00 annually.

CONDITIONS

Maintenance of the Scholarship will be subject to continuing satisfactory performance of above 70%. Yearly submission of school reports will be required by the Bank.
